

# THE MULTIPLE TARGET

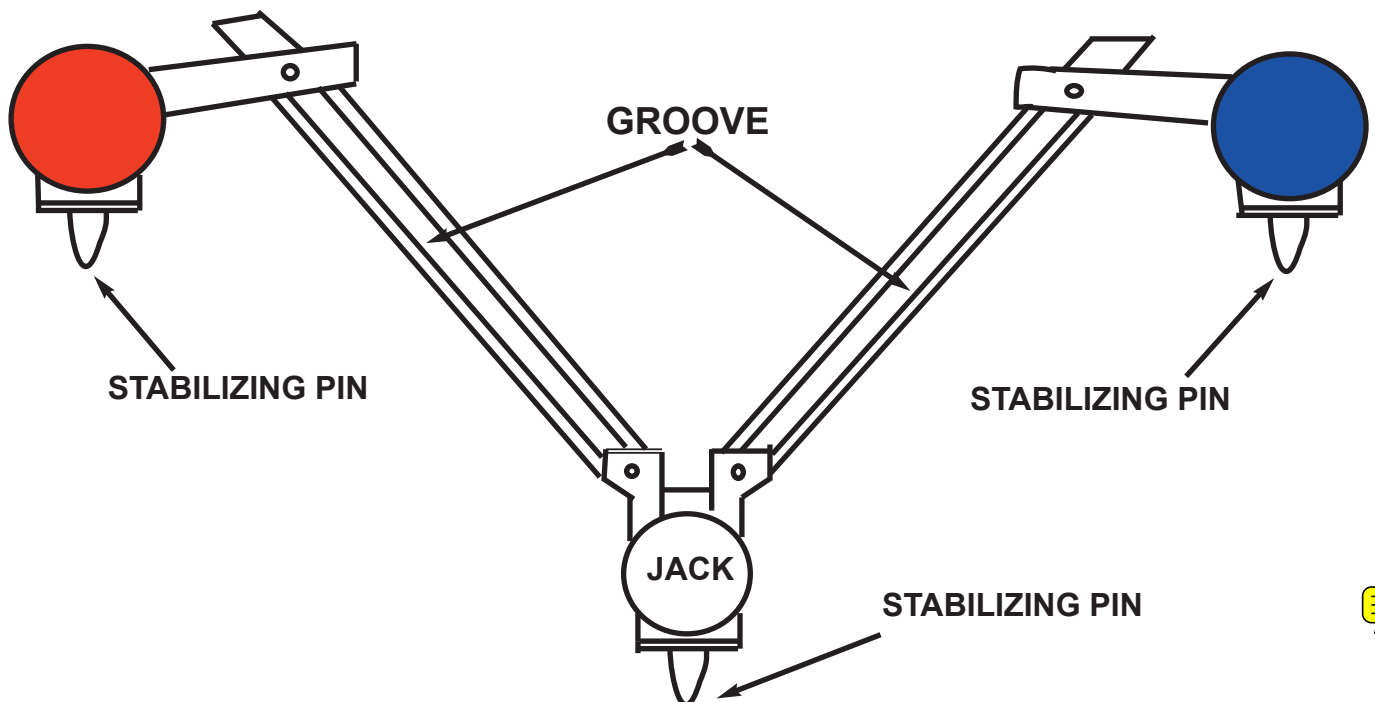
The multiple target is designed to change its configuration of the target that's required within seconds giving you the choice of eleven targets from the one frame. This target is very compact and suitable when attending other venues providing you with an instant variety of shots and practice routines, also other targets maybe created from the main frame at the bowlers discretion.

The flexibility of the target arrives from two arms which are attached to each side to the rear of the main plate and held in position by a swivel pin. The arms are also grooved allowing the target to slide along its frame to the desired setting. The jack is mounted onto the main plate but easy to manipulate by the swivel action of the arms to create the desired setting.

There are two bowl flaps and one jack assembled onto the frame which are easy to manipulate by pinning the jack halfway to the playing surface first in the desired position and then swing the arms to create the desired target and then force the three plates firmly downwards to become static throughout their ordeals.

The Multiple Target provides you with a selection of shots in which is very compact in size and can be carried in your bowls bag without any inconvenience.

There are a selection of coloured patterns available representing the latest coloured bowls which also includes jacks.



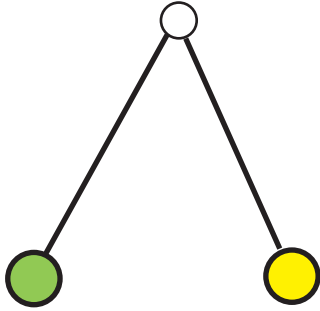

Large Drive Target



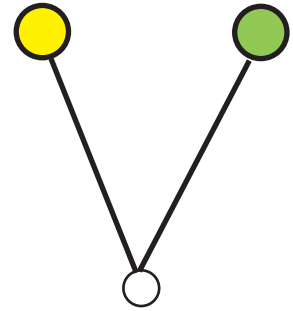

Medium Drive Target



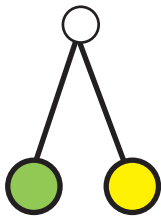

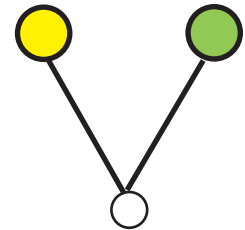

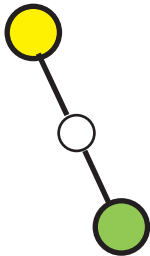

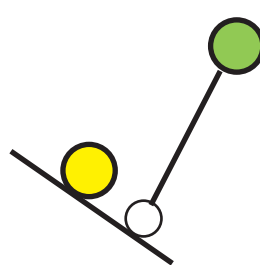

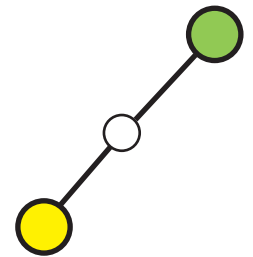
