

THE BOUNDARY MAT

The Boundary Mat is designed for a specific practice routine to draw to the boundary line of a rink which can be placed for the backhand or forehand for the draw shots to this area.

The mat is designed to challenge the bowler which is a specific size with guide lines for scoring points marked out on its playing surface as indicated 1,3,5.

The Jack is permanently affixed to the mat and should be aligned to the boundary pegs of the rink and can be included in scoring points awarded if a toucher should occur within the confines of the rink.

The distance from the mat line to the objective should remain under normal laws of the game in which the practice routine should be harder than a game itself to develop confidence and expertise.

This particular mat is also designed for synthetic surface as well where no damage to the playing surface will occur.
