

THE DELIVERY PRACTICE CHUTE

The delivery practice chute is designed specifically for the delivery of a jack and bowl for the development of the delivery in which provides the concentration for the action without concerning aiming lines and weight.

The delivery practice chute also allows the coach to instruct a new bowler both at the side and front observations during these particular lessons without having to retrieving bowls and begin at the far end. The delivery action are the same for both jack and bowl but there are basic principles that do vary in which can be practiced as the pupil develops for instance the chute can be placed at a angle to the aiming line for the delivery of a bowl once the delivery of such is satisfactory to the coach or instructor.

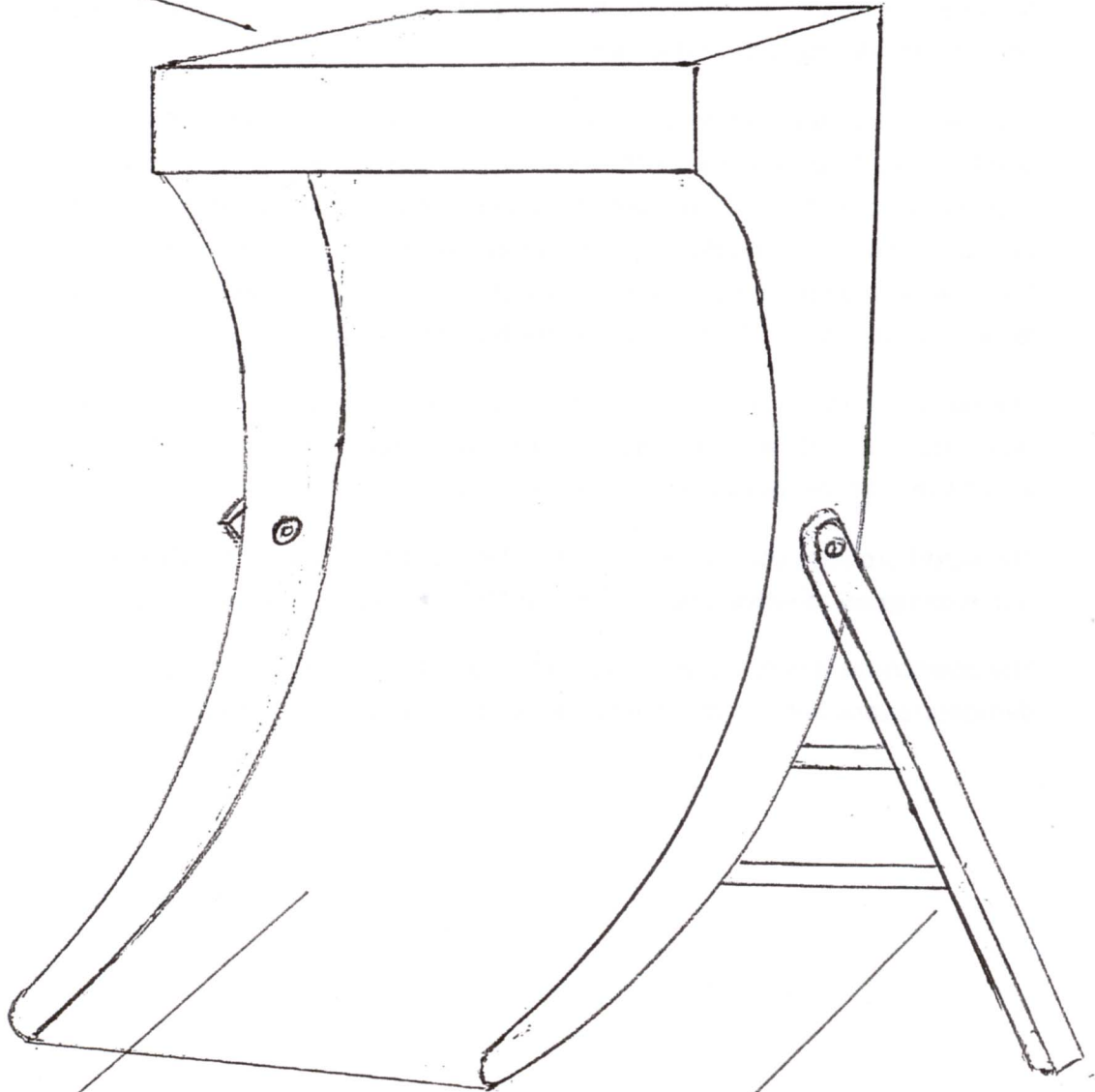
The pupil should stand on the mat about 4 meters from the chute and deliver the jack or bowl into the chute in which the jack or bowl will return back to the pupil each time in which the practice routine is repeated without delays.

The bipod provides the correct angle for the chute which is set is affixed to the main frame but is designed to swivel inward towards the main frame for the purpose of stowage.

The bowl chute is very versatile in which it can be used also for inside coaching tuitions or demonstrations but one of main factors you only need one jack or bowl.
